With today's longer lead times for materials, that meant planning ahead in every aspect we could."

In addition to quality management, making these adjustments seamlessly was only furthered by the highly collaborative environment that Sunrise and Wohlsen have established throughout their partnership.

"Between our management and relationships with the subcontractors and the extremely responsive nature of Sunrise, PWC (the Owner's Representative), and Lantz Boggio (Architect), it's allowed us to keep communication and quality high," Steven shared. "They remain very engaged in the project, and we are very transparent with our process, so there's an elevated level of trust and familiarity."

And now, with the announcement of Mauro Rubbo as designated Regional Vice President of North Jersey, Wohlsen has solidified a go-to partner for continued senior living expansion throughout the region.

"Our goal is to offer mentorship from our experience on previous Sunrise projects to create a synergy with our process in this industry and strengthen the support we can provide moving forward," Steven added.
